Dear Mr. Chairman:

It was gratifying to learn that the Senate Appropriations Committee followed the action taken by your committee in earmarking \$2 million to test the effectiveness of Glo Klen in reducing harmful emissions from coal-fired boilers.

A cost analysis of the proposed Glo Klen test provided by the Austin Company was conducted after your Committee had completed its deliberations. This analysis indicates that a complete test of Glo Klen will cost \$6.27 million.

It is requested that the Conference Committee provide the necessary authority to enable the Department of Energy to provide the additional funding necessary to conduct the full scale test.

Again, we commend your Committee for taking the initial step necessary to seek solutions to acid rain and other environmental problems relating to the use of coal.
