This will acknowledge your communication with respect to the appointment of an Ambassador to the Vatican and universal military training.

While the nomination of General Clark has been withdrawn, there is still a considerable amount of interest in the proposal and I intend to be fully prepared should this be resubmitted and brought up for consideration on the Senate floor.

With respect to universal military training, it is doubtful further action will be taken on this legislation at this session in view of the fact that the House recommitted this bill to committee.
