The Conference Report on the Defense Production Act was adopted without a record vote on Saturday, June 28 by the Senate. No changes were made in the report.

Only for information may I advise that to effectuate an amendment in the report would require that the entire conference report be first rejected by a vote before it could be opened up for amendment.

Doubtless it has already come to your attention, that the House conferees receded from their insistance on the Wolcott amendment to Section 701c referred to on your communication. In other words, the text of the Act as it passed the Senate is retained in the Defense Production Act.
