It was my first impression when the case of Western Medical Corporation first appeared in the press that it related not to legislation but to regulations issued by the Food and Drug Administration.

We found on checking the matter that this was correct and a copy of the release issued by the Federal Security Agency, of which Food and Drug Administration is a part, indicates that the action involving the Western Medical Corporation is a matter of regulation.

I am further advised that the Corporation through its counsel has been presenting the case to the Food and Drug Administration and appealing for relief from the proposed regulations. Inasmuch as the matter is still in process, we will give it good attention.
