This central memoranda file was created by archival staff during processing by collecting extra copies of memoranda found elsewhere in the collection. Among the most interesting memoranda are those about the following: 1952 senatorial campaign committee strategy; economic and political conditions in Illinois (1959); possibility of Dirksen as 1960 vice presidential candidate; reapportionment; school prayer; civil rights; foreign aid; debate on communications satellite bill (1967); and consular treaty with Soviet Union.
